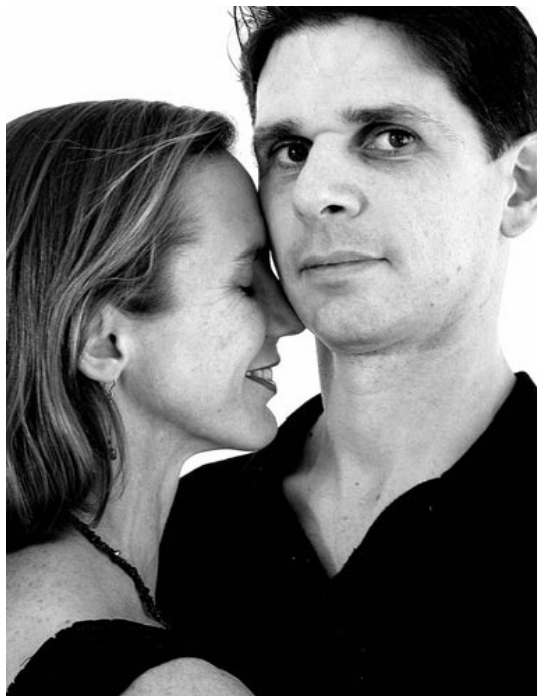


Argentine TANGO with
