Yelena and Avik's skill as instructors has helped develop tango in Ann Arbor tango community, now one of the largest close-embrace communities in North America. They specialize in social tango, emphasizing connection, musicality and navigation—things that inspire improvisation. Their classes are popular and are designed to help students enjoy the process of finding their own tango while respecting the traditions of this century old dance.

In addition to their regular classes in Ann Arbor, Yelena and Avik have been featured instructors in Denver (for the popular Labor Day festival), Cleveland, Pittsburgh, Urbana-Champaign, New York, San Diego, and Mumbai, India. Despite this considerable experience, they continue to have a vivid memory of what it was like to start learning tango and this memory aids their teaching in a profound way. Their classes are fun and students report that Yelena and Avik's passion for the dance is contagious.
