Gustavo was born in Buenos Aires. In the late 90's, he learned tango by studying with teachers who were part of the cast of the show "Tango Argentino," which was a success on Broadway in the 80's. Soon after, he started working as an assistant to several teachers and then trained as a teacher himself by studying technique as well as analyzing tango as a social phenomenon. In 2004 he published <u>Glossary of Tango Dance - Key terms in the dance of Tango Argentino</u>. In 2006, he published <u>Embrace Track - Techniques and Metaphors between Tango and Life</u>. And in 2009 he produced the documentary History of Tango Dance - 1940 / 1960. As a dancer, he has elegance, agility and above all, inexhaustible creativity, based on the technical mastery of the body and knowledge of the possibilities offered by the embrace and emotion.

María was also born in Buenos Aires. She began to dance in her 20s, inspired by a deep love of music and poetry. She began taking classes with Gustavo, and then studied the art with female dancers of great prestige. She further deepened her learning with great milongueros that conveyed to her the excitement of dancing. Her teaching method combines a passion for dance with a broad knowledge of anatomy and kinesthetics that she has acquired from other disciplines such as yoga, pilates and stretching. She also has a broad command of English, and teaches a large number of students from around the world. In 2006 she translated the book "Embrace Track - Techniques and Metaphors between Tango and Life" by Gustavo.
